

## CLUN with CHAPEL LAWN PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of an extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held at the Hazelhurst Close Clun on Thursday, 9 June 2005 at 7.30 p.m.

### **1. Apologies for absence.**

Cllr S Blood, Mrs S Smith and Mrs V Sherring's apologies were accepted

### **2. Declarations of interest.**

**3. Application for Tourism Grant.** Details of the grant application was provided by Cllr Pendry who together with an ad hoc tourism group were requesting a grant from South Shropshire District Council Regeneration Department for 4 new seats at Clun Bridge, 2 at the Memorial Hall, an interpretive sign at the car park, improvements to the Tourist Information point and a new welcome sign on the Craven Arms road. Total cost was £6880.00. In order to secure funding it was necessary for the Parish Council to be responsible for ordering the items and monitoring the finances of the project. It was proposed by Cllr M K Smith that the Parish Council applied for the grant. This was seconded by Cllr Williams. All were in favour

Minute 05-06-18 Resolved that Clun Parish Council accepted ownership of the project.

**4) Planning** there was one application to consider for an extension at Old Rose Cottage, Clun. There were no objections. Clerk was asked to check that the new opening at Turnpike was the stipulated size in the planning permission.

**5) Correspondence to be noted.** A letter had been received from Mr and Mrs Slater's solicitor regarding the decision on the re-siting of the Church Street bus shelter. A copy of the letter had been circulated to members prior to the meeting and the reply and subsequent correspondence was read out to the meeting. Clerk was awaiting advice from Ms Calderbank the monitoring officer. The item may be included on the agenda for the next meeting. The bundle of documents referred to in the correspondence was to be circulated to council members for their inspection.
