- a) Provision of Mirror Buffalo Lane Clun – The Clerk reported that the County Council had put in place the order for the traffic mirror.
- b) Waterloo Ford and Repairs to Clun Bridge – The County Council reported that the improvement works to Waterloo Ford are almost complete so that it can be used by vehicles when Clun Bridge is closed for repair, although part of the Ford has been built using stone filled wire cages this is only a temporary measure with the cages being replaced with concrete late Spring or Summer.
Repairs to the bridge are programmed to on Monday 14th April with work anticipated to take seven days the proposed white line work to Bridge Street will also be carried out when the bridge is closed.
- c) Street Lights – Street Lights out by Methodist Church High Street and the light by the junction High Street/Ford Street.
- d) The Clerk to report the cracked stone pavement by Clun Town Hall.
